We now have to rethink the way we are operating and define a sustainable way forward to support the activities in Touching Africa on a broader base. # The Kingdom Visioned

# Company

Stephan Pretorius

Companies (as legal entities formed by a group of individuals), have a great deal of influence in society as important key cornerstones in creating jobs, wealth, development, and establishment of a social reality. It is therefore fundamental to envision Kingdom structuring of companies to promote a new-order Kingdom-based society.

A company is a corporate person that binds individual people together in a new legal identity. The insight that the Word gives us into this new CORPORATE BODY is therefore very important to understand the functionality of a Kingdom-based Company. It is based on the wisdom of God regarding the

Corporate Structure in mankind and differs substantially from the wisdom of man as applied in the corporate structuring of companies.

The corporate man is an integration of the individual persons that partake in the company and must therefore reflect the combined physical body, the combined cognitive intellectual conscious, and the combined spiritual components of the corporative man. It is a corporate MAN with a corporate BODY, SPIRIT, and SOUL. This is reflected in the company structure as follows:

The physical BODY of the company includes the personnel, property, projects, business products and



services – a physical reality that needs to be ruled and regulated in a specific order.

The SPIRITUAL component of the company is responsible for the real life and value of the company. This is found in the ownership, shareholders and the structure of the company. This component is responsible for the vision, the mission, the operating principles, the passion, and drive of the company. It therefore determines the character of the company.

The SOUL of the corporate body encompasses the cognitive, intellectual and decision-making components of the company as reflected in the management structure of the company. This is made up of the directors, boards, and all levels of management in the company as appointed by the shareholders; to give physical expression to their vision.

It is only possible for a company to give a prophetic expression of the Kingdom of God if this is part of the vision and in the heart of the shareholders – the spirit of the company. If the shareholding of the company is based on “capital investment” the required return on investment will dictate the character of the company as driven by the power of money!

Company management may have an opportunity to bring some changes to reflect Kingdom Principles, but to BE a prophetic building block in a new order society, companies must be owned by people having a Kingdom vision, and not by the economic forces of this world. If the company is managed through a democratic majority voice, the body is taking the lead. If the directors and management of the company are taking the lead, it is dominated by the soul of the company. A sound company, available to reflect Kingdom realities,

consists of shareholders with a Kingdom vision, in balance with a management team that reflects the same heart, expressed through a body available to share the vision.


It will therefore be very important to enable people with a Kingdom vision to be the owners of the companies that they are involved with. This will enable them to give expression to a Kingdom vision through these corporate structures. When people own the company through their power of capital as a tool of investment, MAMMON will be the spirit and owner of the company.

It is important for God’s people to take authority in society through owning companies they can implement Kingdom and righteousness as focus, and a prosperous community will follow. The owners of the companies operating in society have the mandate to change society. If this authority is achieved through capital to grow own riches, the society will be enslaved by Mammon. If this authority is achieved by seeking first the Kingdom and His righteousness, the community will be free to reflect the reality of a new-order Kingdom-based society.

Let us dream about companies owned by Kingdom visioned owners that are free to store treasures in the Kingdom of God (Matt 6:19/20), where the light can shine in the darkness (Matt 6:22/23), not serving Mammon (Matt 6:24), but seeking first the Kingdom of God and His righteousness (Matt 6:33).

# Touching Africa Network

The flow chart above illustrates how interested investors and potential funders can get involved in Touching Africa.

## 1. LINK WITH THE NETWORK

- a. Investors can directly or indirectly link with the network
- b. A direct link is to formally join the network, forming part of a group of people who trust one another, with a shared Kingdom-vision
- c. An indirect link is to link with the network, from an external perspective, without formally forming a part of the network

## 2. IDENTIFY A TOOL

- a. There are multiple institutional tools that can be used as a 'gateway' for funds to flow through
- b. Included in the various tools is the option to get a tax-deductible, section 18A certificate

## 3. IDENTIFY A CO-OPERATIVE

- a. There are six registered and functional co-operatives that can manage and implement funds into new or existing projects and programmes

## 4. IDENTIFY THE PREFERRED PROGRAMME OR PROJECT THROUGH THE SELECTED SPV

- a. A programme is a broader implementation consisting of various smaller projects building into a bigger programme
- b. A project is a focused implementation into specific project actions

This process can be customised and tailored to the benefit of both the funder and the end-user to ensure effective implementation of the allocated funds.

DigiTeams is excited to work with Touching Africa, which is just as committed as we are, to help micro businesses start a website and thrive online fast.







# DIGITEAMS


## *Working Healing through Music*

# Touching Africa Agricultural Co-operative Workshop

In Touching Africa (TA), our dream is to build a network of people with a Kingdom vision in their environment, of which the Agricultural Sector is very important. Approximately 30 farmers attended a meeting that was hosted by TA to develop a forum for discussion and sharing of a Kingdom focus within the Agricultural Sector in South Africa. The strategy in TA is to work towards the development of a Co-operative in each sector, to be available to the network members as an Institutional tool to advance the Kingdom of God as a reality in the corporate world around us.

It was a spiritually deep and enlightening meeting, characterized by remarkable participation from attendees seeking WORD and guidance from the Lord to give HOPE to a hopeless environment. As farmers we really want to hear what the LORD is saying regarding the circumstances in South Africa and the times that we are living in.

We concluded that the Kingdom of GOD is not only a Spiritual reality, it is also an alternative system of governance to the world system, the one we have become used to


in respect of business, farming, the economy and related systems. It stands against the power of darkness (paneros), it is the tree of LIFE against the tree of knowledge of good and evil (there is much "good" in the world system, which we can separate from bad – but it is seized by the world system).

The World system enslaves us to its SYSTEM, while we are SONS of the Kingdom! The world system is based on ownership (money, property, things) versus stewardship of the Kingdom! In this world, the systems are driving us. In the Kingdom the voice of the LORD is our guidance. In this world, we fight for our own interest. In the Kingdom, we submit ourselves to be "IN-CHRIST". The operating SPACE is not own interest, it is IN CHRIST. In this world we act and plan according to our own understanding, in the Kingdom we have the MIND OF CHRIST. There is a difference between knowledge and wisdom (Proverbs 3:5). The world operates from LOGICA: thoughts, the KINGDOM from the LOGOS WORD. The world operates in unrighteousness, the Kingdom operates in righteousness.

From the workshop, we also concluded, that we must stand up as "SONS of GOD" who attend to the business of the Father – and pursue His Kingdom as alternative. The world is waiting for the revealing of the SONS of GOD (Rom 8:22). In the world we work as slaves to survive and build our own kingdoms. In the Kingdom, work is part of our worship – our calling and purpose. Fear, worry and anxiety are the driving force in the world (and is in fact worshipping evil) while TRUST based on a LOVE relationship drives the Kingdom.

We learnt the following:

- Our mandate is to SEEK first the Kingdom of GOD and His righteousness, to be STILL and HEAR the voice of the LORD – on a one-to-one personal level with the LORD. Let us replace the LOGIC of this world with the LOGOS Word of God in our hearts (Rev 2:17). From this, REST, TRUST, revelation of the mind of Christ will follow.
- We are part of a Corporate BODY, the BODY of CHRIST – being together in the space of IN-CHRIST. We are part of God's Local authority on earth, the Ecclesia. We must hear

what the LORD is saying to us – how we can take hands in the Agricultural Sector, and together, BE the BODY of Christ! We need to understand this in order to access God’s power on a corporate level as the BODY (Eph. 3:10) and to be able to walk in UNITY as the BODY that the world can see (Joh 17:24 – 30/Ps 138).

- God works within seasons, and we must understand that we are corporately a BODY in a super important era – we must seek God’s heart in this time! We have an expectation for this countdown on corporate level. This is again confirmed by the prophetic story in Ezekiel 37 – where the Spirit of God came into the dry bones – to prepare a MIGHTY ARMY. We are now in the waiting and interim time of Spiritual preparation – to become MIGHTY warriors in the WARZONE within the World system – and the coming of the Kingdom.

- Our Mandate in this war as farmers in the Agricultural sector – is to serve Africa, while in the past, we had made servants out of Africa. This radical change of mindset must still dawn on us as we change from “landowners”, building our own kingdoms, to “stewards”, building the Kingdom of GOD. We must do this by positioning ourselves close to God. Through this we will bring Kingdom and change in society at a global level.

## The way forward:

From this outcome, we propose the following way forward:

1. We individually undertake to seek the LORD and Word for the time ahead of us, in an expectation of the Spirit of God to give life to the bones on corporate level in our midst (Eze 37).
2. We will create a platform for group communication in order for us to be able to share WORD and vision flowing from this first meeting.
3. We will establish a smaller work group to guide us towards the next step of making a difference in the Agricultural Sector on a practical level. Please contact us if you want to partake in this process!

## Services Co-operative:

# Pumped Storage

**Active members of the IDS co-operative are in the process to develop geo-environmental engineering solutions in the renewable energy field, including solar and hydropower. See one of the concepts explained in more detail below.**


The South African energy crisis and the significant increase in cost of electricity over the past few years has created an environment where investment in renewable energy is increasingly viable.

Although there are several options to generate renewable energy such as solar; hydropower and biomass; the bigger challenge is how to ensure a stable, reliable, and clean supply of baseload energy i.e., how to store this energy. The obvious answer might be to use batteries, but is it really a 'clean'

and lasting solution (will there always be resources to manufacture batteries)? This is where an option such as pumped storage, in combination with solar and/or wind energy, could be considered.

### What is pumped storage?

Pumped storage is based on a scenario that presents itself when there is ample renewable energy available, the wind blows and the sun shines, but people are not using much power. This excess energy is then available to



pump water up to a higher elevated 'reservoir' (as indicated in the picture below) and when sunlight or wind are not generating enough power to meet demand, the pumped hydro system swings into action by discharging water back through turbines that makes up for the 'shortfall'. In essence, this can be seen as a giant renewable battery.


## Is this always a viable option?

At first this solution might seem like a 'no-brainer', but one should remember that a solution like this is very site specific and necessitates a high upfront cost, mainly due to civil works, pumps, and turbines. However, there is a definite tipping point/scale where pumped storage becomes more feasible than other storage options.


Other factors that should be kept in mind when thinking about pumped storage:

- There must be a reasonable height difference (10-250m) within a short distance from each other.
- The ideal would be if there is an existing reservoir/river within the area.
- Trafficability of the terrain.
- Existing electrical network will be beneficial.

All these previously-mentioned factors are some of the critical variables that play a significant role in the feasibility of a such a solution, but it is still worth noting that this is becoming an increasingly viable option due to the ongoing development in technology and the fact that fossil fuels are becoming prohibitively expensive.

Personal and business budgets are crucial, calculating how much our expenses are and what our income is, is very important for any business. In the past, we did not use a budget and we could see that it would not

be viable this way. Once we introduced budgets, we began to see what was a priority and what was not. The marketing segment provided clarity about how to go about marketing and its importance. In the past we would only market when introducing new services and products. Once we made our marketing plan, we were able to see our entire marketing plan and marketing goals.

The time we've spent at the BEEP program was a worthwhile experience and our wish is for other entrepreneurs to join and learn as well. Being around so many likeminded individuals was refreshing. 

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

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
